Types of Novel

1) Realistic Novel:

- Realism
- Novel of manner
- Characters undergo plausible and everyday experience

2) Picaresque Novel:

- Origin: Spanish word- Picaro(rogue)

3) Historical Novel:

- Set in a period earlier than that of the writing.



- **4) Epistolary Novel:**

- -Origin latin word 'epistola'- a letter
- A narration through a series of correspondence document: letters, dairy entries etc.

- **5) Gothic Novel:**

- Terror, mystery, horror, thriller, supernatural , doom, death or decay or haunted buildings

- **6) Autobiographical Novel:**

- -Based on author's personal life
- Mostly in first person narration

7) Allegorical Novel:

Allegory means a story that bears more than one level of meaning.

Symbolic meaning: Political, religious, historical or philosophical

• 8) Utopian/Dystopian Novel :

- - Utopia: imaginary society/community having ideal qualities.



- **9) Psychological Novel:**
 - -treats internal life of protagonist
- **10) Stream of Consciousness Novel:**
 - - Coined by William James
 - -flow of thoughts
 - - incidents in the sequence of their occurrences
- **11) Bildungsroman Novel:**
 - German word- Growth
 - Fictional biography-development: childhood to adulthood
- **12) Science Fiction:**



- - Imaginative concepts: futuristic setting, science and technology, space travel, time travel, parallel universe, innovations
- Mary Shelly's Frankenstein (1823) -first science fiction
- **Detective Fiction:**
- Subgenre of crime fiction and mystery fiction.
